2024 Scholarship Guidelines and Application

- Applicant must reside, and attend a High School, in the City of Portsmouth to be eligible for Zeta Iota's public scholarship.

- Applicant must be a graduating senior.
- Applicant must be an African American Male.
- Applicant must be accepted to an accredited Junior or four-year College or University.
- Applicant must submit:
 - A. A completed scholarship application packet
 - B. Copy of high school transcript with official seal (remove SSN)
 - C. One-page biography
 - D. Current Photo
 - E. At least one letter of recommendation from a school official, e.g., teacher, counselor, coach, band director, or other professional, e.g., employer, pastor, scout leader, mentor, etc.
 - F. Copy of college/university acceptance letter
 - G. A 200–350-word (typewritten, double-spaced, 12-point font) essay on the following topic/question:

How Can A College Degree Help Me Fulfill My Goals In Life?

- The scholarship amount is a **minimum of \$1,000.00** (one time only) which will be sent directly to the college or university after the first official grading period (semester).
